Mayor Bass Highlights Progress Rebuilding the Heart of the Palisades Ahead of Expectations

Los Angeles Mayor Karen Bass highlighted the completion of debris removal at the Palisades Branch Library, which was destroyed in the January wildfires. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers cleared the property of all debris last week ahead of expectations following the Mayor's call to prioritize public spaces in the debris removal operation.

The Army Corps was expected to complete the debris removal process at the library in 30 days – they did it in 6 days. Photos and B-Roll available here.

Last week, Mayor Bass visited the Palisades Recreation Center across the street from the Palisades Library to announce a new public-private partnership with LA Strong Sports, Steadfast LA and key Palisades groups that will fund, redesign and rebuild the Recreation Center, which was partially destroyed and severely damaged during

January's wildfires. Earlier this month, the City announced that it had secured private funding to replace the Pacific Palisades playground.

"My top priority has been to get people home — that means rebuilding houses, but it also means rebuilding the places that make up the heart of this community," said Mayor Karen Bass. "These are city-owned properties and we've worked with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to prioritize debris removal at each of them, including the Palisades Branch Library, to expedite the timeline to get them rebuilt and returned to this community."

"I want to thank Colonel Brian Sawser, Captain Sheldon Tausch, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for their service – our community is truly grateful for their commitment," said Councilwoman Traci Park. "It's critical that we stay focused on removing the roadblocks that slow down recovery. I'm glad to be working with the Mayor to keep these efforts moving forward so that we can help people get home faster."

"The Los Angeles Public Library is enormously grateful for Mayor Bass' leadership and for the Army Corps of Engineers' swift clearing of the site of our beloved Palisades Branch Library," said City Librarian John F. Szabo. "In a time of profound loss for so many, we recognize how fortunate we are to begin to look ahead. We appreciate the team's thoughtful attention to honor our requests for preserving elements of branch history, and we have a renewed sense of hope as we consider the possibilities for what comes next."

Mayor Bass highlighted the start of the rebuilding process in the Palisades last week by visiting two different sites that have been issued building permits from the City. The first permits were issued 57 days after the Palisades Fire began. The first permits took more than twice that time to be issued after both the Camp Fire and the Woolsey Fire.

6 Skills Construction Trade Professionals Need to Have

Basic Engineering Knowledge

Even if you're the plumber, you still need to have at least a little bit of knowledge of the other trades who are working on a job with you—especially if you're working around electrical lines or HVAC units. Distinguishing the types of equipment you and other tradespeople will be using during a job is essential, and knowing how to handle heavy machinery is definitely a plus.

It's about more than just personal documentation. You may have to write emails, send reports, and ask questions while on the job. Brush up your reading and vocabulary for verbal and written communication, and make sure you know how to listen to instructions and follow directions.

Experience With Technology

As technology evolves, there will be new tools and processes that you'll need to learn. Some innovations may become part of your everyday trade, while others may be utilized for training purposes. Every trade industry experiences the impact of technological progress. Even the humble nail gun was revolutionary 100 years ago!

Many construction firms actually have R&D departments to test new technology and keep

up with contemporary tools and equipment. To guarantee you're staying competitive in your market, consider learning about new technologies, including:

- VR (Virtual Reality)
- AR (Augmented Reality)
- Drones
- Mobile Apps
- BIM (Building Information Modeling)
- CAD (Computer-Aided Design)
- CAM (Computer-Aided Manufacturing)

You may even find yourself someday creating training courses for apprentices and other staff about using these tools!

Final Thoughts

Even if you don't have all these skills on your metaphorical tool belt, the most important thing you must have is a willingness to learn. Trade careers continue to evolve and grow with new tools, methods, and techniques that make these jobs more efficient and cost-effective. and the Trump administration, Phase 1 of the debris removal finished in 28 days – months ahead of expectations – and removed more than 300 tons of hazardous materials, such as exploded lithium ion batteries, from the Palisades. In comparison, Phase 1 of the debris removal process for the devastating Camp Fire in Paradise, California took more than twice as long to complete.

- Debris Removal Moving at Historic Pace: In coordination with the County, Phase 2 of the debris removal process is well underway and began just 35 days after the fires ignited roughly half the time it took after the devastating 2018 Woolsey Fire.
- Utilities Restored at Record Rate: In just two months, water and power were safely

restored for standing homes in the Palisades. In comparison, safe drinking water wasn't restored until 18 months after the devastating Camp Fire in Paradise, California.

- Emergency Executive Orders to Return and Rebuild: Mayor Bass used her executive power to cut through red tape, help relocate impacted schools and childcare facilities, provide tax relief for small businesses, expedite the rebuilding of homes and businesses in ways that better protect against future wildfires, and more.
- Reinforced Burn Areas Prone To Slides: The City shored up burn areas ahead of wet weather this season by urgently installing more than 10,000 feet of concrete barriers and laying down more than 6,500 sandbags.
- Provided Relief and Protections to Fire Survivors:

Opened a Disaster Recovery Center to centralize critical resources from 70 city, county, state, and federal agencies. More than 9,500 households and counting have been helped so far.

- Opened the One-Stop Rebuilding Center to help streamline the rebuilding of homes and businesses.
- * Worked with the Governor's Office to ensure homeowners can access as-built plans and allow the City to automatically re-issue permits for homes built in recent years.
- * Opened four new Impacted Worker and Family Recovery Centers to help residents with job placement, financial assistance, youth opportunities, and more.
- * Signed new City ordinances to:
 - Deliver tax relief for local businesses that were destroyed or severely eco-

- nomically impacted by the wildfires.
- Prohibit residential evictions for tenants housing people or pets displaced by the wildfires for the next year.
- Prohibit price gouging for essential housing, lodging, and consumer goods and services, including contractor services for debris removal and rebuilding, during a declared state of emergency.
- Federal and State Support: Mayor Bass led a Council delegation to Sacramento to advocate for support to rebuild. The delegation met with Governor Gavin Newsom, California State Senate President Pro Tempore Senator Mike McGuire, California State Assembly Speaker Robert Rivas and other state leaders.

such as DEI, I wouldn't have the opportunities that I have today," says Tonia Dunbar, Director of Professional Services at Trimble and a board member for the Trimble Foundation Fund. "Historically, and even currently, people of minority ethnicities are underrepresented in many industries, but vastly underrepresented in construction."

DEI helps drive the impact of having diverse thought, diverse representation and helping in-advertently drive businesses. "As the chair of the black professional network, which is one of our employee resource networks within Trimble, we have many that represent various groups, or underrepresented groups, not only from an ethnic background, but from other representation backgrounds."

The Trimble Foundation established a DEI subcommittee to give back to communities, not just within the United States, but globally, she says. The company is focused not only on impacting communities, but also local businesses to make sure people have equal opportunity and equal access.

2. How has the conversation regarding DEI changed - specifically to technology - or been prioritized since you began your career?

The recent highlights of civil unrest, especially in the United States, have driven people to open their eyes a little bit and get comfortable being uncomfortable, Dunbar says.

"DEI really is about that. It's about having the hard conversations. It's about addressing the topics of race and addressing the topics of equity for the underrepresented and that makes people uncomfortable."

"If I look back 15 years ago to now, I think we've got into a transition of leadership across the globe, across many industries that have said this can't keep happening or have said our businesses are not being as successful as they need to be because we don't have enough diverse perspective," she says. "Quite frankly, the world is moving in a direction in terms of how it operates

very differently than 15 years ago."

Dunbar points to the online virtual world called the Metaverse, NFTs and the Pandemic as new items businesses now have to grapple with today and in the future. "This is a global pandemic which nobody has experienced and then has turned all industries upside down and how we operate. DEI became extremely important because you have to do things differently to continue to be successful. That challenges the status quo of where people's comfort levels have been historically in pushing them outside of that box."

3. What factors or initiatives and changes in attitude need to happen for the construction industry to embrace the adoption and acceptance of DEI?

"First and foremost construction has to make sure they're ready," Dunbar says. "If we're having an open and honest conversation, the history of the industry shows that we're extremely slow to adopt a lot of things, such as technology and operational success, and DEI is no exception. What we have to understand is in order for it to be impactful, we have to be ready. So what does that mean?"

Dunbar says despite the obvious lack of minorities in construction, everyone should be aware of the depth of the issue when it comes to that lack of diversity. Nearly 90% of the construction industry is white and male, when they only make up 78% of the labor force for all industries, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor statistics.

"We have a problem in what we're doing in terms of creating that diverse opportunity within the construction industry, which could drive how much better we're building our buildings, how much better we're utilizing our technological resources and program and project management software to execute these projects," she says. "Firms are becoming increasingly intentional about this change of scope in the diversity in the workforce and making construction more inclusive for all people, which is great."

But the construction industry needs to be more inclusive.

Owners should take a hard look at criteria on selecting subcontractors that allow for disad-

vantaged business enterprises, for instance, to qualify, she says. Dunbar suggests owners review surety and experience modification ratings for safety and set specific goals for their GCs, such as maybe 25 to 30% inclusion, for illustration's sake.

"You have to put some accountability metrics in place as a part of that readiness to help support driving DEI as something that we have to do, not something that just sounds good," Dunbar says. "We have to really be ready and focused on getting it done."

4. What advice would you share with construction owners and businesses for not only attracting, but retaining this sort of diverse, needed talent?

Dunbar says construction firms need to be creative in their approaches not only to retain talent but to attract talent as well. It's important to align people with where their passions are and consider equity allocations. Millennials in particular place a high value on being able to make an impact in an organization.

"You've got to start really engaging with your employee base on where their passion lies and where they feel like they're having the most impact. When people feel like they're being impactful and their passion is being effective, then they're going to stay despite all of the compensation," she says.

"The other thing that is very important to these generations is that they're not having any of this non-diverse thought. Historically I think our previous generations were very comfortable with just some things you just don't talk about and you move on. These generations are challenging because they want to know that they're working in organizations that are all inclusive of all people," Dunbar says.

It's important not just to talk about diversity in the construction industry, but to demonstrate your organization is taking action as well.
