Editor’s note: August is National Black Business Month, founded in 2004 by Black entrepreneurs Frederick E. Jordan, an engineer, and John William Templeton, a publisher and historian, to highlight and support Black-owned businesses.

Black entrepreneurs play a valuable role in our nation’s economy. According to the United States Census Bureau’s recent estimates, the United States has more than 161,000 Black-owned businesses, bringing in over \$183 billion annually. Yet, Black Americans remain under-represented among United States entrepreneurs and are often less likely to receive funding from lenders than their white counterparts.

In an effort to help close this opportunity gap, here is an extensive list of resources geared toward supporting Black entrepreneurs.

The Black Business Alliance

The Connecticut-based Black Business Alliance (BBA) works with Black business owners both in the state and nationwide to promote and grow small and medium-sized Black- and minority-owned businesses. Since 2014, the BBA has worked with over 600 business owners and professionals to provide economic development, business workshops, networking opportunities, and access to capital.

Additionally, minority small business owners in Connecticut can apply for the Minority Business Revolving Loan Fund (MBRLF), facilitated by BBA in partnership with the state and the Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD). The MBRLF program offers loans up to \$100,000 to eligible applicants. Those interested in applying must first complete an intake form and meet with a representative from BBA.

Black Business Association

The Los Angeles-based Black Business Association advocates for policies to increase access to contract and procurement opportunities in both the public and private sectors. Members can access networking events, training and resources, and funding opportunities designed for Black business owners and professionals.

The 5 Phases of a Construction Project

All construction projects require careful planning to succeed. You need to coordinate resources and equipment, set timelines and budgets, and manage various moving parts throughout the build.

To keep that process organized, construction work is commonly divided into defined stages. This allows you to plan, manage, and track work as it moves from early concept through completion.

So what are the phases of a construction project? One widely used framework comes from the Construction Management Association of America (CMAA), which defines the construction lifecycle in five stages: pre-design, design, procurement, construction and monitoring, and post-construction.

In this article, we explain these five construction project phases, including the key activities and challenges of each, and provide some tips to ensure your next construction project is a success.

What Are the Phases of Construction?

In the construction industry, reputations are built on how efficiently a firm or contractor manages the process and how well they can handle the unexpected. While details vary by project, the construction phases of a building or structure generally start with planning and conclude with closeout.

The five phases of construction project management include:

1. Pre-Design (Project Initiation)
2. Design (Pre-Construction)
3. Procurement
4. Construction and Monitoring
5. Post Construction (Closeout)

The 5 Phases of Construction Project Management Explained

Every successful build follows a structured path from concept to completion. Understanding how each step connects helps you plan smarter, con-



trol risk, and keep momentum from day one.

Phase 1: Pre-Design (Project Initiation)

The first phase of a construction project is the pre-design phase, which some companies also call the planning or initiation phase. This phase covers the entire period before the building or structure is designed, and schematics are created.

During the pre-design phase, project managers and their teams evaluate the project’s requirements, objectives, and overall feasibility, and then establish a project budget to work from.

This phase is absolutely crucial to the project as a whole because it allows stakeholders to assess whether it’s a good idea to actually go ahead with the project. It also sets a solid foundation for how to execute all aspects of the project if it does, in fact, go ahead.

Key Activities

Here are some activities that usually occur during the pre-design phase:

- **Undertaking a Feasibility Study:** The planning team carries out a feasibility study to assess the project’s merits and evaluate its objectives. The study looks at things like construction costs, design, location, and the proposed building schedule.
- **Setting the Initial Scope, Budget, and Timeline:** Early in the project, the team establishes the basic boundaries of the work. This step clarifies the overall size and purpose of the build, sets financial limits, and defines when the project needs to be completed. Documenting these expectations at the start gives designers and planners clear direction as decisions move forward.
- **Site Analysis and Site Inspection:** Before any work begins, the site itself needs to be checked. This step confirms ground conditions, access to utilities, and any physical constraints that could affect construction.

In short:

- An invitation to bid (ITB) is a request you send to subcontractors, asking them to price one specific part of a project.
- The software you use to manage ITBs is called bid management software. It builds your bid packages, sends invites, tracks replies, and shows your coverage in one place.
- Prequalifying subs before you invite them means checking their safety, finances, licensing, and past work, so unqualified bidders stay out of your package.
- Bid coverage means having enough qualified bids per trade. It is the number that tells you if your final bid is competitive.
- ConstructConnect® Bid Management gives you one workflow to prequalify subs, send branded ITBs, and track coverage across every active project.

An invitation to bid, or ITB, is one of the most important tools a general contractor uses during preconstruction. It is how you ask subcontractors to price a specific scope of work on a project.

When your ITB is clear, targeted, and easy to respond to, you have a better shot at getting enough qualified bids to build a competitive number. On the contrary, when your ITB is vague, incomplete, or sent to the wrong subcontractors, bid day gets a lot more stressful.

That is why many general contractors now use bid management software instead of juggling spreadsheets, inboxes, and old contact lists. In fact, 71.5% of contractors use bid management platforms on a regular basis.

This blog explains what an invitation to bid is, what to include in one, how to improve subcontractor response rates, and how ConstructConnect Bid Management helps general contractors send better ITBs, prequalify subcontractors, and track bid coverage in one connected workflow.

What is an invitation to bid (ITB) in construction?

An invitation to bid in construction is a request that a general contractor sends to subcontractors, asking them to submit pricing for a defined portion of a project.

A strong ITB usually includes:

- The project name, location, and job type
- The scope of work for the trade being bid
- The plans, specifications, and any addenda needed to price the work correctly
- The bid due date, time, and instructions for submitting pricing
- Pre-bid meeting or site walk details (if required)
- Any bonding, insurance, or prequalification requirements

In simple terms, an ITB tells a subcontractor, "Here's the job, here's the scope, and here is what you need to price it."

Invitation to bid vs. request for proposal

An invitation to bid is not the same as a request for proposal, or RFP. An ITB asks for a price on work that is already defined. An RFP asks bidders to explain how they would approach the work, including methods and qualifications, not just price.

For most trade bidding workflows, general contractors use ITBs when they need clear pricing from subcontractors on a known scope.

Why ITBs matter to general contractors

For general contractors, the goal is not just to send invitations, but to secure enough qualified bids in every trade to build a confident number.

That is where many teams get stuck. Sending 40 invites does not mean you have coverage. What matters is whether you have enough qualified subcontractors actually bidding in each scope.

Strong ITBs help you:

- Reach the right subcontractors faster
- Reduce back-and-forth on missing documents
- Improve response rates
- Spot trade gaps before bid day
- Build more competitive pricing from a stronger bid pool

What software do general contractors use to manage invitations to bid?

Bid management software replaces the old process of managing bid packages through separate spreadsheets, email threads, manual follow-up, and more.

Verifying these details early helps teams avoid surprises once equipment and crews are on-site.

- **Creating a Project Initiation Document (PID):** Next, a PID is usually created based on the results of the feasibility study. This document defines the scope of the project, sets project milestones for the team to meet, and defines the criteria that determine the project’s success in the eyes of stakeholders.
- **Developing Preliminary Schedules:** Once you’ve defined key milestones, you need a high-level schedule to guide the work ahead. At this stage, you’re not planning

day by day, but outlining major timing considerations, such as when to order long-lead items (LLIs) and when design, permitting, and construction transition from one phase to the next. This stage also helps you align expectations around when work will start and when the project is likely to be completed.

- **Defining the Project Team and Roles:** Before blueprints are drawn, you need to identify and document which team member does what.
