Use of proceeds with an SBA loan

When you apply for an SBA 7(a) loan, you must provide a detailed plan of what you'll do with the money. You may be allowed to use these loans for a variety of purposes, but they must include one or more of the following:

- Acquiring, refinancing, or improving real estate and buildings
- Short- and long-term working capital
- Refinancing current business debt
- Purchasing and installation of machinery and equipment, including AI-related expenses
- Purchasing furniture, fixtures, and supplies
- Changes of ownership (complete or partial)
- Multiple-purpose loans, including any of the above

1. Acquiring, refinancing, or improving real estate and buildings

You may be able to use your SBA loan to buy a new facility, refinance your mortgage, or perform upgrades on current real estate and buildings. This is especially important for businesses that are moving into a space that was formerly used for another purpose as well as those that need to expand their footprint.

2. Short- and long-term working capital

Working capital supports day-to-day business operations and is calculated as current assets minus current liabilities. Maintaining positive working capital typically helps cover ongoing expenses.

You may also use SBA loan funds to support hiring, marketing, and other operational needs.

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The Preconstruction Talent Gap: Why It Matters and What to Do About It

The labor shortage and talent gap have been top of mind for the construction industry, and for good reason: with skilled professionals leaving the workforce faster than they can be replaced, companies are facing challenges in maintaining productivity and preserving institutional knowledge.

This issue is especially pronounced in the preconstruction phase, where success depends on specialized expertise that takes years to develop. As veteran preconstruction professionals leave the industry, they're taking decades of hard-earned knowledge with them. And because that expertise can't be developed overnight, firms can't simply hire their way out of the problem.

So, the challenge isn't just about hiring new talent but capturing and scaling the knowledge that already exists.

Why the talent gap is growing

One of the things that makes a preconstruction professional successful is hands-on, real-world experience. Think about it: a seasoned estimator can spot missing scope before it turns into a change order. An experienced preconstruction manager knows which design details are likely to create constructability issues or where budgets tend to drift.

Those instincts don't come from a textbook. They come from years of working through projects, learning from mistakes, and seeing how project decisions are made.

Unfortunately, today's workforce is losing that experience faster than it can be replaced. The median age of construction workers is 42, and the industry expects a significant wave of retirements over the next several years. What's more, demand for skilled workers continues to outpace supply. The construction industry is expected to need roughly 439,000 additional workers beyond normal hiring needs to meet demand.



Preconstruction faces the same challenges, but with an added layer of difficulty because expertise takes a lot of time to build. Companies can hire junior talent, but they can't fast-track the judgment that comes from spending years estimating projects, coordinating with design teams, and managing risk. That's the experience gap many firms are grappling with today.

Why the talent gap matters for preconstruction

Preconstruction sets the direction for the entire project. When experienced professionals are in short supply, projects are much more difficult to execute. These challenges can come in the form of:

- Teams having fewer people who can spot scope gaps, challenge assumptions, or catch risks.
- Estimates missing important context that only comes from years of similar projects.
- Organizations become overly dependent on a handful of senior team members, which can slow decisions.

The result is more uncertainty, more rework, and more pressure on the people who hold the most institutional knowledge.

The hidden challenge: knowledge is often tribal

Beyond finding and keeping skilled people, you also need to preserve and document what they know.

But too often, critical knowledge lives in the heads of experienced estimators and preconstruction managers rather than in documented

processes or shared systems.

They remember which subcontractors consistently over- or underbid, what risks surfaced on similar projects, and which assumptions proved costly in the past.

The problem is that this knowledge isn't always captured in a way the rest of the team can use. Best practices may vary from one estimator to another, and important decisions can depend on who happens to be assigned to a project.

So, when experienced employees retire or move on, they take that institutional knowledge with them. New hires can eventually build those same instincts, but it won't happen right away. Until then, teams risk repeating past mistakes instead of building on what they've already learned.

Why traditional approaches fall short

Hiring and training are important to solving the challenges outlined above, but they aren't enough on their own.

New team members need time and project experience before they can make the same judgment calls as seasoned professionals. At the same time, many preconstruction teams still rely on spreadsheets, email threads, and individual workflows that make it difficult to share knowledge consistently across the organization. As a result, critical information stays siloed, and teams continue to depend on a small number of experts.

3. Refinancing current business debt

Leveraging debt is a common method of scaling businesses. However, depending on the type of debt that you’re carrying on your books, refinancing it may be a better option. It’s important to note that borrowers typically need to provide a clear business rationale for a loan to refinance other debt. However, if you have steady cash flow and want to reduce interest rates and make your debt repayments more predictable, an SBA loan may be a great option.

4. Purchasing and installation of machinery and equipment, including AI-related expenses

Upgrading and maintaining equipment is essential for operational efficiency. An SBA loan is often a lower-cost way to finance equipment with repayment terms that better match cash flow.

This option is especially helpful if your business operates in an industry in which technology is constantly evolving. Ensuring that you continue to operate efficiently while exceeding the expectations of your clientele is crucial, and purchasing new equipment may be a great way to do that.

5. Purchasing furniture, fixtures, and supplies

SBA loan proceeds are often used to purchase fixtures, furniture, materials, machinery, and other items needed to outfit or upgrade a business location.

may be able to use one loan for multiple purposes.
