

Mayor Bass celebrates 818 Day, focusing on investments and progress.

Mayor Karen Bass celebrated 818 Day, the annual day of recognition to highlight San Fernando Valley businesses, culture, and the region’s many contributions to the city of Los Angeles.

“There is no Los Angeles without the contributions of the San Fernando Valley,” said Mayor Bass. “This 818 Day, we celebrate the incredible businesses, culture, and communities of the Valley and continue our work to improve public safety, reduce homelessness, build more housing, and accelerate economic growth across the region.”

Investments and Progress in the San Fernando Valley

- Improving Public Safety:** Burglaries in the Valley are down by 42% since last August. Mayor Bass announced a surge of LAPD resources following a spike in break-ins while also advancing key community safety initiatives like Summer Night Lights, which served more than 50,000 Angelenos across seven Valley parks this summer. The Mayor also secured more than \$2 million in federal funding to support CIRCLE in the Valley, which sends trained mental health professionals to respond to non-violent crisis calls.
- Investing in the Sepulveda Basin:** Mayor Bass is leading a targeted, multi-agency restoration strategy in the Basin to clear brush and debris, remove long-standing encampments, and reduce public safety threats. Fire-related incidents have decreased by 31% compared to the same time period in 2024. Mayor Bass also secured \$22 million in new state funding specifically allocated to maintain efforts in the Sepulveda Basin.
- Reducing Street Homelessness:** More than 900 people have been brought inside and more than 268 tons of debris were cleared through 29 Inside Safe operations conducted in Van Nuys, Woodland Hills, Canoga Park, North Hollywood, Chatsworth,

Which U.S. Construction Sectors Are Growing Fastest in 2026

In short:

- Data centers, power infrastructure, and healthcare lead U.S. construction sector growth in 2026: These three sectors are attracting the strongest contractor demand, with data centers posting a net +57% contractor confidence reading, the highest of any sector tracked in the AGC 2026 Hiring and Business Outlook.
- The South holds the most active planning pipeline: Over 56% of near-term construction potential is concentrated in the South, led by Texas, Virginia, North Carolina, Georgia, and Florida, driven by data center, industrial, and manufacturing investment.
- National backlogs are at their highest level in nearly a year: The ABC Construction Backlog Indicator reached 8.8 months in June 2026.
- A full backlog can mask concentration risk: If too much work sits in one sector or region, a single demand shift can expose the entire pipeline with little runway to adjust.

What Is Construction Sector Growth and Backlog Risk?

Construction sector growth measures how many new projects are entering the planning and preconstruction pipeline in a given market. Project backlog measures how much committed work a contractor already has on the books. You need both views to see where opportunity is building, and whether your team has the capacity to pursue it. Growth shows where the next opportunities are forming; backlog shows how much concentration risk your team is already carrying. Track only one, and you risk either missing the best opportunities or chasing work your team cannot deliver well.

The Fastest-Growing U.S. Construction Sectors in 2026

Construction is not moving in one direction this year. ConstructConnect’s project pipeline data points to three sectors generating the most new

planning and preconstruction activity: data centers, power infrastructure, and healthcare. All three are pulling well ahead of traditional commercial and residential construction, which remains under pressure from financing costs and softening demand.

Third-party research confirms the pattern. The Deloitte 2026 Engineering and Construction Industry Outlook frames why: total investment in structures is projected to grow nearly 1.8% in 2026, but much of that growth is concentrated in AI-related data centers and the energy infrastructure needed to support them. As of mid-2025, commercial construction spending had declined approximately 8.2% year over year, leaving a gap of more than 10 percentage points between the strongest and weakest-performing sectors.

Momentum is strongest in data centers, power infrastructure, and healthcare—not in the traditional commercial and residential segments that remain under pressure. For a broader look at the economic forces behind this shift, read our analysis of the state of the construction economy in 2026, which explores the demand trends shaping each major market.

Where U.S. Construction Work Is Concentrating in 2026

Construction sector momentum isn’t evenly distributed across the country. The South is the most active planning region in 2026, followed by the

Midwest. According to ConstructConnect News, more than 56% of investment is concentrated in the South, with another 26.7% in the Midwest. Within the South, Texas, Virginia, North Carolina, Georgia, and Florida carry the heaviest project pipelines, driven by hyperscale data center development, automotive and aerospace manufacturing, and logistics infrastructure.

A current snapshot from ConstructConnect® Project Intelligence identifies 85 data center projects in late-stage preconstruction with scheduled start dates before year-end, representing \$78.2 billion in planned value. The Southeast and South Central regions account for the largest shares of that pipeline. For broader monthly context on regional data center starts, see ConstructConnect’s data center construction reports.

For building product manufacturers (BPMs) and general contractors (GCs), geography can matter as much as sector. A strong Southeast data center pipeline may create a compelling opportunity today—but it can also leave a team or product line vulnerable if that pipeline slows or shifts.

Which Construction Sectors Carry the Deepest Backlogs in 2026

The sector breakdown tells a more specific story than the national headline. Contractors working

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TECHNOLOGY IN CONSTRUCTION

Maintaining Humanity Amidst the Rise of AI

Putting people in charge of AI goes beyond a tech-savvy new hire. A top-down approach, starting in the C-suite, often provides the best adoption oversight and ensures consistent company culture.

With the rise of artificial intelligence, robotics and more technology across the construction industry, companies are creating roles for not only specific technology assets, but also the innovation of those assets, the sweeping adoption of entire tech stacks and overall integration of technology within the company.

Connico—a consulting firm that specializes in cost estimating, scheduling, project management and project controls for aviation, federal and energy infrastructure—is one of those companies. Its newest role—director of digital transformation—is focused specifically on evaluating emerging technologies, like artificial intelligence and large language models, overseeing their implementation and ensuring those tools are fully integrated into day-to-day workflows across the business.

While the role is new to Connico, the person filling it is not new to the type of work it involves. Mihail Risteski has been in the construction industry for nearly two decades and has been a trusted client advisor with Connico for four years, previously serving as senior scheduler.

“One of my passions,” he says, “has always been technology or at least systems that improve how we do things.” Before the creation of his current director role, Connico’s leadership offered Risteski the opportunity to lead an innovation group exploring tools available in the construction technology market. Soon after, the team realized they needed somebody to lead the tech venture full time. Six months ago, unsurprisingly, Risteski was asked to step into the director of digital transformation role. What did surprise him about the role, though, was how hands-on it is from a strategy and adoption standpoint. As director of digital transformation, Risteski is not just selecting tools, but driving real usage across teams, building internal buy-in and tying it back to business performance.

He sat down with Construction Executive to provide perspective on what AI adoption actually looks like inside a firm that’s actively building the function.

It’s becoming a trend among the C-suite, especially in construction, for roles to be created specifically for technology. How do companies find the right people to fill these new roles?

It depends on the situation. When Connico set out to fill this role, one of the biggest considerations was our culture. Our vision is that Connico is the best place to work, and we are a very people-focused company.

in data centers, power infrastructure, and major public projects are carrying the deepest backlogs—in some cases 10 or 12 months of committed work. Smaller regional contractors focused on traditional commercial and residential work are running much thinner, closer to four months in some cases. That gap is one of the defining features of the 2026 construction market.

The ABC Construction Backlog Indicator reached 8.8 months nationally in June 2026—the highest level in nearly a year—but that average masks the divide between these two groups.

Healthcare construction backlog is building as the year progresses, while manufacturing-sector work remains steady. Office and retail are softer. Contractors in those segments are competing harder for smaller projects—and thinner margins.

What Backlog Concentration Level Signals Pursuit Risk?

A full backlog can look healthy and still hide risk. The issue is not just how much work is on the books, but what kind of work it is, where it is concentrated, and whether your team can deliver it. Backlog becomes a risk signal when too much of it sits in one sector, with one client, in one region, or within one trade specialty. If any single category accounts for more than 40–50% of committed pipeline value, take a closer look

before adding more work in that same category.

The Birmingham Group’s 2026 backlog risk analysis recommends sorting backlog into three practical buckets:

- Protected work: Known clients, proven sectors, realistic schedules, strong trade coverage, and a team equipped to deliver.
- Watch-list work: Solid projects with at least one or two exposed variables: thin trade coverage, slow owner response, delayed design decisions, or a key hire still open.
- Pressure work: Projects won tight, staffed thin, priced aggressively, or running on schedules the team does not fully believe in.

When Watch-list or Pressure work starts to dominate, the overall backlog number can become misleading—especially in a sector experiencing a demand correction. The same warning applies to trade contractors (TCs) and BPMs: rely too heavily on one sector, and a slowdown there can open a revenue gap before you have time to fill it.

Mayor Bass celebrates 818 Day, focusing on investments and progress

- Pacoima, Reseda, Granada Hills, Panorama City, Sun Valley, Shadow Hills, Arleta, North Hills, and Valley Glen.
- Building Affordable Housing:** Mayor Bass recently unveiled the largest affordable housing project approved under her Executive Directive 1 – signed during her first week in office to slash red tape and streamline the approval of 100% affordable housing. Viva Warner Center will provide more than 3,000 units of affordable housing for LA’s senior population. To date, Mayor Bass has fast-tracked more than 12,000 affordable housing units in the Valley to address the City’s housing and affordability crisis head-on.
- Improving Public Transportation & Accessibility:** As a member of the Metro Board – and now Chair of the Board – Mayor Bass voted to approve the Sepulveda Transit Corridor, a transformative rail connection plan that will link the San Fernando Valley to the Westside. The City has also broken ground on the Chandler Bikeway connection, which will create a continuous

- 21 mile bikeway from Chatsworth to Burbank. Upgrades continue on the Metro G Line to deliver faster, more reliable Metro service for Valley residents.
- Delivering Basic City Services:** In the Valley alone last year, City crews removed more than 1.8 million square feet of graffiti, filled nearly 23,00 potholes and completed more than 420,000 requests for item and illegal dumping pickups.
- Repairing and Replacing Up to 60,000 Street Lights Citywide:** Alongside Councilmember Monica Rodriguez and community members in Pacoima, Mayor Bass launched a historic new initiative that will clear the City’s street light repair backlog by replacing 60,000 street lights citywide harnessing solar street light technology. New solar lights have already been installed in Canoga Park, Sherman Oaks, Sun Valley, Sylmar, Northridge, North Hollywood and Pacoima.
- Advancing a “Games For All”:** Mayor Bass recently marked two years out from the start of the 2028 Paralympic Games at Birmingham Community High School in

- Lake Balboa, the site of the first official wheelchair basketball game. The San Fernando Valley will become a global hub in 2028 with the Sepulveda Basin set to host sporting events like 3x3 Basketball, Skateboarding, and BMX Racing. The Universal Studios Lot will also make history, hosting the Olympic debut of Squash.
- Bringing the World Cup to Every Community:** 36 free “Kick it in the Park” community celebrations were hosted across the Valley for the 2026 FIFA World Cup, where 13,500 Angelenos watched matches for free at the Hansen Dam, Northridge Recreation Center Lanark Recreation Center, Sylmar Recreation Center, Whitsett Fields, and Sheldon-Arleta Park.
- Boosting the Entertainment Industry:** Earlier this year, Mayor Bass cut the ribbon on the new Cinespace Studios in Woodland Hills, a 108,000 square foot campus and the company’s first studio in Los Angeles, which has already secured multiple productions. Mayor Bass successfully advocated for the historic doubling in the State’s Film and TV Tax Credit, and she has continued

- to cut fees and advance policies to make filming in L.A. easier and more affordable.
 - Historic Climate Action:** In April, Mayor Bass announced her Climate Action Plan for Los Angeles at the Donald C. Tillman Water Reclamation Plant in Van Nuys, which is currently under construction to double its water-purifying capacity, a huge win for environmental sustainability. The approval to double the capacity of this facility was made under Mayor Bass’ leadership. Once complete in 2027, the facility will be able to purify 45 million gallons of water a day – enough for 500,000 Angelenos – and reduce LADWP’s reliance on imported water, including water that feeds Mono Lake. Under Mayor Bass’ leadership, Los Angeles has achieved historic clean energy milestones – from the full divestment from coal in our power supply to the completion of the Eland Solar-plus-Storage Center, one of the largest solar and battery storage projects in the country, and the doubling of fast chargers for electric vehicles
