

From Highways to Healthy Communities: Transforming How California Invests in Transportation

The Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1956 proposed the audacious goal of connecting the United States with a 41,000 mile federal interstate system. Since the Highway Act's signing, California fully built out its interstate and state highway system, expanding mobility access for car-owners, stimulating economic development, and creating thousands of jobs. But these benefits came with unacceptable and avoidable costs.

From the 1950s to 1970s, highway planners and decision-makers repeatedly chose low-income neighborhoods for the construction of new highways. The justification? These communities already faced disinvestment and underdevelopment, compared to wealthier, whiter communities which were more likely to push back against the development of highways in their neighborhoods.

As a result, highway projects tore through the hearts of communities of color, physically segregating low-income neighborhoods from wealthy ones, while displacing over a million people. In addition to burdening neighboring communities

with higher rates of pollution, these highways physically impeded the access of low-income communities of color to job opportunities, quality education, and essential resources like healthy food, exacerbating existing inequities.

In California, proposed highway expansion projects continue to demonstrate this structural racism is far from a thing of the past. A previously planned expansion of Interstate 710 between Long Beach and East LA would have displaced homes and increased toxic diesel pollution in already overburdened neighborhoods. The project was only canceled in May 2022 by LA Metro and Caltrans following decades of community organizing led by the Coalition for Environmental Health and Justice.

Separately, community-based organizations in South Fresno have filed suit against Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration in opposition to another project that would expand and add traffic to State Route 99, exacerbating environmental injustices and undermining state agency efforts to combat those injustices. And just last week, the California Transportation Commission approved funding for more than \$600 million dollars in Caltrans-recommended

How Our New Rule Will Help Construction Workers

The federal government is making historic investments in infrastructure, which means investing in workers. A new rule will help ensure that construction workers on federally funded projects are fairly compensated – meaning more money to take home to their families and communities. Here’s what you need to know.

Prevailing wages

The rule will update the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts, which aim to ensure that construction workers on federally funded (or assisted) construction projects are paid locally prevailing wages – and that the government’s construction contracting activity doesn’t have the unintended consequence of depressing workers’ wages.

Better accuracy and efficiency

In the past, wage determinations weren’t regularly updated and sometimes fell years behind actual wages. The new rule will help us calculate prevailing wages more regularly, accurately and efficiently. Some prevailing wage rates will update periodically to avoid becoming outdated. A more efficient



survey process facilitated by the final rule means frequent Davis-Bacon wage surveys, ensuring that workers on federal jobs don’t have to wait 10 years for their wages to be updated to the locally prevailing rate. The rule also recognizes that the Wage and Hour Division has the authority to adopt state or local wage determinations as the federal prevailing wage under certain criteria.

Updated definitions

Updated definitions will improve clarity. The rule will return to the definition of “prevailing wage” used from 1935 to 1983, to ensure prevailing wages more often reflect actual wages. It also updates the definition of “building or work” to include 21st century projects like energy infrastructure and clarifies that truck drivers and other worksite principles are covered.

Stronger worker protections

The final rule includes debarment and new anti-retaliation provisions, meaning more enforcement options and stronger protections of worker rights.

Strengthening and streamlining the wage determination process will ensure wages paid to workers on federally funded construction projects better reflect the realities of today’s labor market. When employers compete on equal footing, it benefits construction workers, their families, their communities and taxpayers.

Davis-Bacon Act regulations are as important as they’ve ever been, and this new rule will ensure that they address the modern workforce as we make unprecedented investments in America’s roads, bridges, federal buildings and energy infrastructure. As these projects open up opportunities around the nation, we’re ensuring that they’re creating good jobs with fair compensation and safe conditions.

IRS: Builders of qualified new energy efficient homes might qualify for an expanded tax credit under Section 45L

The Internal Revenue Service reminds eligible contractors who build or substantially reconstruct qualified new energy efficient homes that they might qualify for a tax credit up to \$5,000 per home.

The actual amount of the credit depends on eligibility requirements such as the type of home, the home’s energy efficiency and the date when someone buys or leases the home. This important credit was expanded as part of the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022.

Eligibility for builders and homes

To qualify, eligible contractors must construct or substantially reconstruct a qualified new energy efficient home. They also must own the home and have a basis in it during the construction, and they must sell or lease the home to a person for use as a residence.

The homes must also be specified categories of single-family (including manufactured) or multifamily homes under Energy Star programs, be located in the United States, and meet applicable energy saving requirements based on home type and acquisition date.

Requirements and credit amounts for 2023 and after

For homes acquired in 2023 through 2032, the credit amount ranges from \$500 to \$5,000, depending on the standards met, which include:

- Energy Star program requirements
- Zero energy ready home program requirements
- Prevailing wage requirements

Requirements and credit amounts before 2023

For homes acquired before 2023, the credit amount is \$1,000 or \$2,000, depending on the standards met, which include:

- Certifying that the home has an annual level of heating and cooling energy consumption that is at least 50% (or 30% for certain manufactured homes) less than that of a comparable home that meets certain energy standards, with building envelope component improvements accounting for at least 1/5 (or 1/3 for certain manufactured homes) of the reduction
- Meeting certain federal manufactured home rules
- Meeting certain Energy Star requirements

Transforming How California Invests in Transportation

projects that will further expand the state's highway network, generating more pollution and congestion that is again sure to place the heaviest burden on low-income communities of color. California needs strong infrastructure. But it can't come at the expense of our communities.

California is long overdue to overhaul racist highway-building practices that exacerbate the nation's worst air pollution in predominantly low-income communities of color and undermine the state's climate goals. And as last week's CTC funding approval demonstrates, existing policies are not changing actual investment outcomes. We need systemic solutions to address this systemic problem.

AB 1525: The Accelerating Communities through Transportation Act intended to do just that. Greenlining partnered with Assemblymember Mia Bonta on the bill. This legislation would have required that at least 60 percent of transportation dollars go to projects benefiting disadvantaged populations, in a way that would shift dollars away from harmful highway projects and towards walking, biking, and transit projects that would meet communities' needs.

Despite overwhelming support from advocates and community organizations, the legislation, facing opposition from highway groups, was held in the Assembly's fiscal committee. The death of this bill and Assemblymember Bryan's AB 2419 before it, speaks to a larger issue – an unwillingness to align public investments with equity, climate, and, most importantly, communities' needs.



The injustices shaped by our past decisions are not blueprints for our future. Sixty-seven years from the Federal-Aid Highway Act, it's time we prioritize building a future where communities can thrive with clean air, efficient public transit systems, safe bike lanes and sidewalks, and affordable, zero-emission car-sharing programs. If we succeed in changing course, we can create high-road jobs—and potentially more of them—while spurring economic development that is both robust and inclusive.

California reached its own transportation milestone at the end of June, as Governor Newsom signed the largest Caltrans budget to date, with over \$20 billion for transportation infrastructure. To build the clean, equitable transportation system that Californians deserve, our state's leaders should start by committing to spend the money we have now to address community-identified needs and priorities.

How This Small Business Found the Sweet Recipe for Success

Reggie Borders had been trying to perfect his aunt's pound cake ever since he got his hands on the recipe. After baking four cakes for a fundraiser at his mother-in-law's local church, a dozen more orders sprung up. Pretty soon, everyone seemed to have a sweet tooth and Borders secured his business license a year later.

Pound Bizness was founded in Oakland, California, in 2018 by Borders and wife Nicole Felix-Borders and it quickly leap frogged into a small business. The husband-and-wife duo's greatest challenge was first understanding the foundation needed to build a solid business.

"Almost every day we learn something new and add an additional part of the foundation," said Nicole. "Once you attain the right resources and education, you can learn how to scale and what you need in order to propel your business forward."

For the Borders, it's important to pay it forward after finding success with their small business. The Pound Bizness co-founders have partnered with The David E Glover Education and Technology Center, the East Oakland Collective and the Black Cultural Zone to donate slices throughout the pandemic. They have also given support to other local entrepreneurs through their Pound for Pound scholarship, contributing a portion of their funds to college students just starting out.

"We're mindful of the impact our business can have now," said Reggie. "When you're just starting a business, you're not always going to get everything right, it's ever evolving, it's not static. That's why it's so important to find mentors to help you understand what's out there and what your blind spots are."

After going through a round of Currency Conversations at Chase for some financial tips and tools, the couple started working with Chase Senior Business Consultant Nykole Prevost through the bank's new initiative empowering minority entrepreneurs.

The initiative, part of the firm's broader racial equity commitment, is designed to help entrepreneurs in historically underserved communities with solution and business-focused resources. "By working with [our senior business consultant] Nykole Prevost at Chase, we were able to get guidance around the process to obtain our Minority Business Enterprise certification through the Western Regional Minority Supplier Diversity Council and certification from the U.S. Black Chambers," said Nicole.

Prevost worked closely with the Borders on accomplishing their goal to obtain their MBE cer-

tifications. Prevost reflects on their journey, "although we started with the MBE certifications as a goal, it quickly developed into ensuring each slice from Pound Bizness was accessible to all large partners. Since certification, I've been helping to empower Reggie and Nicole to scale more slices to a larger community."

When asked about Pound Bizness' future growth goals, Nicole said, "A slice of cake is an introduction to so many different types of conversations. We want to make Pound Bizness a household name and our business mentor at Chase is part of the journey."

For other entrepreneurs looking to bring their ideas to reality Nicole recommends "step back and work on your business, versus always working within your business. Getting your infrastructure in place is just as important as improving your product or service."

"This journey isn't going to be easy, and you can't do it alone," said Reggie. "Don't be afraid to ask for mentors and share your vision with your community, family and friends. It will take all of them to help you grow your business."
