

Size Standards Change Would Upend Small Business Access to Federal Contracts

Late last week, the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) issued a new proposed rule, which would dramatically increase the size of companies considered “small” for purposes of federal programs, including procurement preferences. While the proposed rule cites a goal of simplification, it upends decades of precedent and is a major revamp that would merge nearly 1,000 categories under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS), to just 338 and would create a significant competitive disadvantage for many small businesses.

“The SBA estimates that an additional 114,541 firms will now be classified as small, which may sound small given there are millions of small businesses, but don’t be fooled: those companies have significant economic heft and already have federal contracts worth more than \$71 billion, 40 percent of the total held by the entire small-business community last year,” stated NSBA President and CEO Todd McCracken.

Many of the NAICS categories would undergo massive size increases, such as Custom Computer Programing Services – it would skyrocket in revenue caps from \$34 million today to a whopping \$531 million, a 1462% increase. This means that a company with around \$20 million in revenue, because many of these contractors are far under the current cap, would compete with a company earning more than \$500 million. This is not the only massive increase.

Further complicating matters, the proposal allows only a 30-day comment period, a wildly expedited timeline for such a massive rewrite of rules that impact millions of small businesses.

“If simplification is truly the goal here, why give small businesses just 30 days to respond? Do we as small businesses want regulatory simplification? Of course, but the simplification in this rule will actually benefit large businesses and federal contractors far more,” stated NSBA Board Chair Bill Belknap of AEORNG, a federal contracting firm in Pennsylvania. “The so-called “solution” this rule provides is actually far worse than the clunky nature of the current NAICS.”

NSBA is urging, at best, a re-think on the entire proposal, and, at a minimum, more time to respond.

Mayor Bass and Councilmember Rodriguez celebrate new pipeline completion.

Mayor Karen Bass joined Councilmember Monica Rodriguez and leaders from the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to celebrate a major construction milestone on the Foothill Trunk Line Project, advancing the City’s commitment to proactively replace aging infrastructure and build a stronger, more resilient Los Angeles. The Foothill Trunk Line is a critical part of the City’s water distribution system, transporting large volumes of water from reservoirs and facilities to smaller distribution mainlines serving local communities. Originally built in the 1930s, the aging pipeline ranges from 24 to 36 inches in diameter and is being replaced with a new 54-inch-diameter earthquake-resilient pipeline using welded steel pipe and Earthquake Resistant Ductile Iron Pipe (ERDIP). ERDIP features flexible joints designed to accommodate ground movement during an earthquake.

“This historic project is an example of the critical, proactive infrastructure work that is happening behind the scenes, but makes a real difference for Angelenos,” said Mayor Bass. “This

project means more reliable water service, better water quality, and resilient infrastructure built to serve Angelenos for decades to come. For too long, Los Angeles has waited for infrastructure to fail before fixing it, and we are changing that and building for the future.”

“Upgrading our City’s water infrastructure is a matter of public safety and equity for all Angelenos,” said Councilmember Monica Rodriguez. “For decades, our communities relied on aging pipelines built in the 1930s. By securing this record-setting investment in earthquake-resilient infrastructure right here in Council District 7, we are protecting our neighborhoods from seismic risks, ensuring our first responders have the water they need in a crisis, and guaranteeing reliable service for generations of Valley families to come.”

“Replacing century-old water infrastructure is a major undertaking, but it’s essential to maintaining a world class system here in Los Angeles,” said Allan Marks, President of the Board of Water and Power Commissioners. “We’re modernizing key components and building new facilities to ensure LADWP delivers reliable, affordable, high-quality water to our communities. This includes installing earthquake-resistant pipelines and updated infrastructure, implementing smart monitoring systems, and expanding local water supplies through groundwater cleanup, stormwater capture, and recycled water.”

“Our promise to the community is straightforward: dependable, high-quality water, day in and day out,” said David W. Hanson, LADWP’s Interim General Manager. “Over 20 years, we’ve nearly tripled our annual mainline pipe replacement to 240,000 feet per year, including more than 41,000 feet of earthquake resilient pipe. These upgrades strengthen reliability and

the numbers speak for themselves. LADWP’s water leak rate is half the national average and ahead of any of our peers across the country. We are very proud of this accomplishment and intend to get even better over the years.”

Crews have installed more than 4 miles of earthquake-resilient pipe as part of the Foothill Trunk Line Project, making it the largest and longest large-diameter earthquake-resistant ductile iron pipe installation in the nation.

The Foothill Trunk Line Project is part of LADWP’s ongoing effort to strengthen the reliability and resilience of Los Angeles’ water system. Across the City, LADWP has installed 67.2 miles of earthquake-resilient pipe since 2012, with additional projects planned.

This project is just one of the major infrastructure investments announced this week. On Monday, Mayor Bass joined City leaders in the San Fernando Valley to celebrate the opening of two new state-of-the-art groundwater treatment facilities in North Hollywood that will treat up to 43 million gallons of contaminated groundwater every day to provide safe drinking water for hundreds of thousands of Angelenos. These investments also advance the goals of Mayor Bass’ Climate Action Plan, which sets ambitious targets for climate resilience and water sustainability, including reaching a 70% local water supply by 2035.

The Foothill Trunk Line Project also advances Mayor Bass’ broader commitment to proactive and coordinated infrastructure investment through the City’s first-ever Capital Infrastructure Program (CIP) that Mayor Bass released earlier this year.

New Report Links Owner Behavior to Project Success

A new industry report argues that project success depends as much on owner behavior as contractor performance—and outlines five practices that help create better outcomes for everyone.

Contractors often spend considerable time discussing what separates high-performing builders from the rest of the field. But a new report suggests the industry has been asking only half the question.

“What Great Owners Do,” a new study published by the University Research Institute, shifts the

focus upstream, examining how owners influence project outcomes long before schedules slip or budgets overrun. Drawing on insights from leaders representing government agencies, healthcare systems, contractors, designers and construction organizations—including Associated Builders and Contractors President and CEO Michael Bellaman—the report argues that exceptional owners don’t simply fund projects; they actively shape the environment that allows project teams to succeed.

For contractors, the report is noteworthy because its recommendations are not directed at improving contractor performance. Instead,

they describe how owners can become better partners—creating conditions that improve collaboration, reduce risk, attract the industry’s best builders and ultimately produce better projects.

At a time when skilled labor remains constrained, projects continue to grow in complexity and owners increasingly compete for top-performing contractors, those lessons may be more relevant than ever.

LEADERSHIP STARTS WITH THE OWNER

The report begins with a simple premise: While many variables influence project success, one

- factor is often overlooked—the owner’s role in establishing the culture, expectations and operating environment for the entire team.
- Rather than revisiting familiar discussions around procurement or delivery methods, the authors identify five behaviors they believe consistently distinguish exceptional owners:
- Create a clear mission and continually reinforce it.
 - Remain visible and engaged throughout the project.

- Actively manage collaboration.
 - Help project partners succeed.
 - Think beyond a single project toward long-term program improvement.
- Collectively, these recommendations challenge a common assumption within construction—that assembling a qualified project team is sufficient to ensure success. According to the report, it isn’t.
