

# Which States Are Best for Construction Businesses To Thrive in 2025?

Top 9 States With the Most Construction Work in 2025

Contractors looking to grow in 2025 should consider states with high construction activity, job growth, and businessfriendly conditions. This guide ranks the top contenders based on recent labor data, demand, and market potential.

If you're wondering what state has the most construction work in 2025, the answer is clear: Texas leads the way in job volume, followed closely by Florida and California. But project volume is just one part of the equation. For contractors and construction business This article breaks down the best states for construction jobs and business expansion, using the latest numbers from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics and other industry sources. We'll look at national trends, labor projections, and the top nine states seeing the most construction activity in 2025.

#### The U.S. Construction Outlook for 2025

Construction businesses across the U.S. are preparing for a year of steady demand, but with sharp differences by region. On a national level, three major trends are shaping the construction industry:

- Federal infrastructure funding is flowing into transportation, broadband, and energy projects.
- Labor shortages continue to affect project timelines and wages.
- Population growth is reshaping local demand, especially in the South and Mountain West.

Construction activity is healthy overall, but location has never mattered more. Some states are attracting significantly more infrastructure projects than others, and the cost of doing business varies widely. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment in the construction sector continues to rise, but contractors need to be strategic about where they set up shop.

Industry Trends and Labor Market Projections

Federal initiatives, clean energy goals, and private sector investment are driving construction opportunities in 2025. The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) data shows above-average job growth for construction occupations, especially in:

• Tech-driven builds like data centers and advanced manufacturing facilities

# Mayor Bass signs directive to ensure projects finish on time

Mayor Karen Bass signed an executive directive to streamline processes and strengthen efficiency at the City's three proprietary departments: Los Angeles World Airports, the Port of Los Angeles and Los Angeles Department of Water and Power. As Los Angeles prepares for transformative infrastructure investments and major events in the coming years, Mayor Bass' executive directive overhauls outdated review processes, enabling faster decision-making and stronger financial management, without compromising oversight or accountability. These improvements will help ensure that major capital infra-

structure projects reach completion on time and within budget.

"From rebuilding in the Palisades to the construction of the Convention Center project, Los Angeles has important capital infrastructure and maintenance projects underway," said Mayor Bass. "This is to ensure that we use every available tool to help LAX and Van Nuys Airport, Port of Los Angeles and Department of Water and Power succeed at delivering infrastructure projects on time and on budget. My executive directive streamlines processes with a new and coordinated approach to keep projects moving on schedule. When City Hall works more effectively and efficiently, we deliver for Angelenos."

The directive lays the operational foundation necessary to support projects by improving the contract review process, coordinates across departments and plans for the future. Executive Directive 15 supersedes a 20-year-old executive directive, reinforcing the Mayor's commitment to championing forward-looking governance to meet the demands of today's L.A., one that is investing billions in infrastructure, growing its economy and preparing for the global stage through key projects including:

- Historic investment in airport asset renewal of critical mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire protection, infrastructure and utility assets that have reached or exceed their useful life.
- The hardening of public infrastructure to continue driving the fastest natural disaster recovery in modern California history.
- Construction of a goods movement training facility and modernization of the existing cruise terminal, among other efforts at the Port of Los Angeles.
- Innovative design of LAX's Airfield & Terminal Modernization Project (ATMP) to reduce traffic back-ups on surrounding

- public streets and improve the customer experience.
- Electrification of the modernization and expansion of the Los Angeles Convention Center to revitalize Downtown L.A. and boost the economy.

Bolstering her executive directive, Mayor Bass sent a letter to the City Council calling on Councilmembers to use their legislative powers to further reduce bureaucracy by aligning the authorities of the General Manager and Boards of the Airport and Harbor Department with those of the Department of Water and Power and making some straightforward contracting processes less burdensome. These alignments will save time and money for the Airport and Port as they carry out complex infrastructure and logistics projects.

This week, Mayor Bass took bold action, giving the final approval to modernize and expand the Convention Center. She hailed it as a milestone in Downtown L.A.'s revitalization, which has struggled to recover from slow foot traffic and office space vacancies brought on by the pandemic.



Barragán's use of bright colors is but one distinguishing feature of his designs. Born in Guadalajara, Mexico, Barragán focused his studies on engineering, and was self-taught with his architectural skills. Following his graduation, Barragán traveled to Europe and was inspired by vernacular architecture, specifically that of Mediterranean and North African cultures. He referred to himself as a land-

scape architect, advocating for the importance of designing gardens and the exterior environments of buildings. Some of Barragán's notable projects include: Casa Barragán, Torresde Satelite, Casa Gilardi, Chapel of the Capuchinas, Casa Prieto Lopez and many more. In recognition of his achievements, Barragán was awarded the Pritzker Architecture Prize, often referred to as the Nobel Prize of architecture.

#### Ismael Levva (1952-Present)

Born in Mexico, Levya decided at the age of 15 that he would be an architect. In his early career, he moved to New York City working as a draftsman before opening his own practice in 1996, which would become Ismael Leyva Architects,

one of the most respected architecture firms in New York City. Some of Leyva and his firms' projects include: Time Warner Center, 15 Hudson Yards, 60 Water Street, Torres Paseo Colón and many more.

César Pelli (1926-2019)

Born in Argentina, Pelli was one of the 20th century's most distinguished architects. César attended National University Tucumán where he received his bachelor's degree in architecture. Following his studies, Pelli moved to the United States, attending University of Illinois to pursue his master's degree. Pelli served as dean of Yale's School of Architecture and established his own practice in Connecticut. His work is notable for its lightweight appearance, often clad with glass or thin stone veneer. Notable projects include: Pacific Design Center

in Los Angeles, the U.S. embassy in Tokyo, Museum of Modern Art expansion and renovation in New York City, World Financial Center and Winter Garden in New York City, Petronas Twin Towers in Malaysia, the Republica in Argentina and the Canary Wharf Tower in London. Of the many honors he received, one was the Aga Khan Award, given every three years "to identify and encourage building concepts that successfully address the needs and aspirations of societies in which Muslims have a significant presence." César Pelli also received the AIA 1995 Gold Medal.

Bilbao is a Mexico City native, born August 2. 1972. She is a powerhouse in the architectural realm of merging geometry with nature. Bilbao

Founded to support the local community, Karish Industries operates as an employee stock ownership plan (ESOP) company, empowering their employees through shared ownership of the business. While they had already performed successfully on California State contracts, they knew the federal market held greater opportunities but needed guidance to navigate the complex federal contracting landscape.

As Karish Industries grew over the years, they faced a significant challenge with their SAM (System for Award Management) registration renewal. The SAM system had recently been updated and was experiencing numerous technical issues affecting both renewals and new registrations. Additionally, the employee who had been their authorized representative was no longer with the company, creating an access barrier. Partner Bruce Smith knew that resolving these registration issues was critical to pursuing federal contracting opportunities and reached out to Norcal APEX Accelerator

Norcal APEX Accelerator immediately went to work on the SAM renewal during their first meeting. Within one month of connecting, Bruce was able to submit a notarized letter to SAM to regain account access and begin the renewal process. However, once they accessed the account and submitted renewal information, they discovered that the banking information was outdated and couldn't be changed after submission. After numerous meetings and calls to the SAM help desk, Norcal APEX Accelerator helped them determine that starting a completely new registration would be the best path forward.

While working through the SAM registration challenges, Bruce actively participated in Norcal APEX Accelerator training webinars and procurement fairs to learn about and network with government agencies. Taking advantage of their location near federal laboratories like Lawrence Livermore and Sandia labs. Bruce was able to connect with his counselor in person during public events. Thanks to efforts from their APEX counselor, Karish Industries was able to get connected directly with the labs and be included on the list of attending firms for networking events.

'We are eternally grateful for Norcal APEX Accelerator and their staff of experts and professionals," shared Bruce Smith, Partner. 'They gave us the tools and advice to participate in government contracts and gain visibility and interaction with government agencies, elevating our company to the next level."

With Norcal APEX Accelerator's support and Karish Industries' perseverance, they successfully completed their new SAM registration and continued submitting bids to state and local agencies, winning various contracts with local city and county agencies. They began selling to Caltrans, the Coast Guard, and various military agencies. Most significantly, with their completed SAM registration, they were able to connect with Lawrence Livermore Laboratories to become a preferred vendor for upcoming projects.

Karish Industries continues to win contracts in the local, state, and federal markets, knowing they have the ongoing support needed to sustain their success in government contracting while maintaining their commitment to employee ownership and community support.
