

## Mayor Bass Celebrates Port of Los Angeles Groundbreaking on \$152 Million Avalon Pedestrian Bridge And Promenade Gateway Project

Mayor Karen Bass today celebrated the groundbreaking of the new \$152 million Avalon Pedestrian Bridge and Promenade Gateway project in Wilmington, which will provide pedestrian and bicycle access to the Wilmington Waterfront Promenade and transform 12 acres of former industrial land into community-centered spaces for residents.

“We are thrilled to begin construction on this transformational project that will create more green space and recreational opportunities for Wilmington residents and visitors alike,” said Mayor Bass. “By transforming 12 acres of former industrial land, this project is one of the many ways we are working to revitalize, reimagine, and build connections in communities across the city. I want to thank Governor Newsom, Councilmember McOsker, the LA Board of Harbor Commissioners, and the Port for moving this historic investment forward that will benefit residents and local businesses for generations to come.”

“The Avalon Pedestrian Bridge represents another major step forward for Wilmington and the continued transformation of our waterfront,” said Los Angeles City Council member Tim McOsker, whose 15th District includes the Port and Wilmington. “This project builds on the success of the Wilmington Waterfront Promenade by adding safe, direct access across the railroad while increasing much-needed green space for families to gather and enjoy. The investment will strengthen the connection between Avalon

Boulevard and the waterfront, supporting local businesses and creating new opportunities for the community to thrive.”

“Investing in our communities and expanding public access to our waterfront has long been a priority at the Port of Los Angeles,” said Los Angeles Harbor Commission President Lucille Roybal-Allard. “The building of this beautiful new bridge and gateway recreational area represents another step toward achieving that goal.”

“This project was made possible because of our Public Access Investment Plan, which ties community investment to our cargo success,” said Port Executive Director Gene Seroka. “But this project is more than simply building a bridge. It’s about giving the Wilmington community safe and direct waterfront access for the very first time.”

### About the Avalon Pedestrian Bridge and Promenade Gateway Project

Port and City Officials worked closely with residents to design the community-focused project that will create unprecedented public access to the Wilmington Waterfront Promenade via a new signature 380-foot-long bridge that will also connect to a new open space public recreation area—the Avalon Promenade Gateway—also being built as part of the project.

The open space will feature a landscaped entry plaza with an iconic 40-foot-tall architectural sundial, a historic walk and overlook, an open terrace seating area, pedestrian pathways, community gathering areas, two parking lots and public restrooms. The project also involves

Mentorship doesn’t stop once you think you have all the knowledge. It is the stomping grounds designed to generate the next generation of leaders whether it be the future chief financial officer, vice president or even president. More importantly, it is meant to produce a meaningful mentor-mentee relationship for junior and senior employees. As strong relationships are curated and trust is built, long tenures are curated. That is evidenced by the 20% of R.D. Olson staff who have spent their entire careers at the company, coming full circle from a new employee to a leader inspiring others.

### Fostering Collaboration
